



HIGHWAY CONTRACT: MTO 2005 - 5009 AUGUST 2006

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Four laning of Highway 69, over a 6.8 km distance, in a northerly direction, beginning 4.2 km south of Highway 124 (Seguin River). Work will include: approximately 1,000,000 m3 of rock excavation and 400,000 m3 of earth and muskeg excavation; 12 new bridges; 2 bridge rehabilitations; 2 new interchanges at Parry Sound Drive and Hwy 124; 500,000 tones of aggregate surfacing and 20,000 m3 of poured concrete.

ACTIVITIES OF NOTE

The project involves extensive rock excavation and blasting. Lane closures may occur between 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Some night work on bridge structures can be expected. Equipment operations will include rock crushers, above and below grade surface excavators, rock trucks (30-40 tonne capacity), dozers, loaders and graders. The MTO design will preserve as much as possible of the exposed mylonite, just north of Parry Sound Drive. Construction activities are subject to DFO, MOE and MNR environmental requirements and local noise abatement requirements, as set out in the contract. Crew receive training on the protection of the Eastern Massasauga Rattlesnake.
